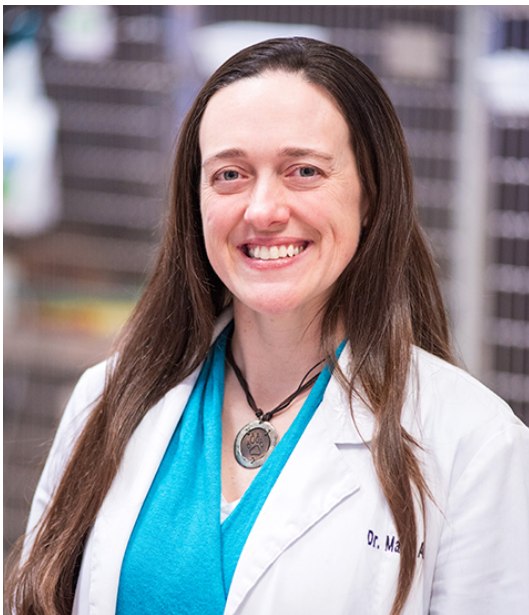




Marlo Perich (Anderson)
